Since this is a program for students from partner universities, you only pay the costs for the ISP service package.


Academic and language courses are covered through the exchange agreement between your home university and TU Dortmund University and the tuition you are paying there.

TRACK A: ENGINEERING

This track is designed for students from partner universities in their third or fourth year. It is also suitable for graduate students.

You will get hands-on project work to gain practical experience. You can select from a catalogue of courses in the following fields:

- Applied Mathematics
- Automation & Robotics
- Biochemical & Chemic Engineering
- Computer Science

Your course selection is complemented by two mandatory courses in German language and culture. A research project in addition to or instead of the regular ISP is possible.



TRACK B: GERMAN & EUROPEAN STUDIES

This track is offered to American and other international students from partner universities interested in German language, literature and culture in European and global contexts.

In the cultural studies classes, you will join German students in order to explore new developments in German and European culture from different points of view.

If you are interested in a special academic topic, you will be assisted in independent study projects by professors and specialists from different fields.

Your course selection is complemented by two mandatory courses in German language and culture.



TRACK C: ENTREPRENEURSHIP *NEW*

This track is designed for international and Dortmund students who are interested in international business issues and understanding how to cope with current problems on global markets.

You can select from a catalogue of courses in the following fields:
