## Stakeholder Takeaways



### The Role of Education

- Integrate teaching of SD & SDGs into early education to build awareness in the next generation of decision makers.
- Incorporate SD & SDG education into STEM coursework to deepen intersectional awareness between policy and science.
- Foster cultural exchange at all educational and professional levels.
- Promote interdisciplinary practices for advancement beyond the scope of one discipline's ability.
- Strengthen science communication for effective messaging across diverse audiences.



### The Need for Inclusion

- Recruit diverse diplomats and UN representatives by building relationships with institutions of higher education to attract talent outside of policy and governance fields of study.
- Work with local communities and support regional initiatives.
- Use language that is accessible and transparent.
- Incorporate local, traditional, and indigenous knowledge into decision-making processes on SD and in the implementation of SDGs.
- Foster avenues for citizen science.



### The Relevance of Trust Building

- SD is based on trust that is not only about rationality but also incorporates empathy and ethical engagement.
- Authentically engage with stakeholders, especially local community members.
- Reflect on history of science and acknowledge shortcomings.
- Be open and transparent about interests and values.
- Build common ground and engage in open discourse.
- Diversify expert groups and intentionally foster intersectional representation.

### Remaining Challenges:

- Cementing UN core values including universality, neutrality, integrity, and evidence-based decision-making.
- Fostering academic freedom and science exchange in authoritarian and non-democratic societies.
- Making higher education accessible and affordable to cultivate global citizens.
- Ensuring the role of applied science institutions is equally recognized.
- Incentivizing leaders to promote community engagement from the top-down.
- Balancing interest-based & value-based SD; recognizing geo-strategic competition.
